Accommodations will be provided at the Embassy Suites Orlando-Lake Buena Vista Hotel . The prices below include 3 nights stay, golf, and the Awards banquet.

<h2>The Competition</h2>
Friday through Sunday —Three-day INDIVIDUAL stroke play championship by flights (we will have 4 or 5 flights). Play within flights will be net. Multiple prizes in each flight paying out approx. 30% of the field.
Friday-Saturday —Plus there is a simultaneous TEAM event. The National Tour Team trophy will be awarded Saturday night at the banquet. Optional side pools may include: low gross, low net, gross birdie skins, net birdie skins (all \$20); longest putt (\$10) and poker (\$10). [In poker, each entrant is dealt 4 cards when he or she comes in. You get one extra card for every par 3 green you hit in regulation. The best hand from a maximum of five cards wins the whole pot.]
